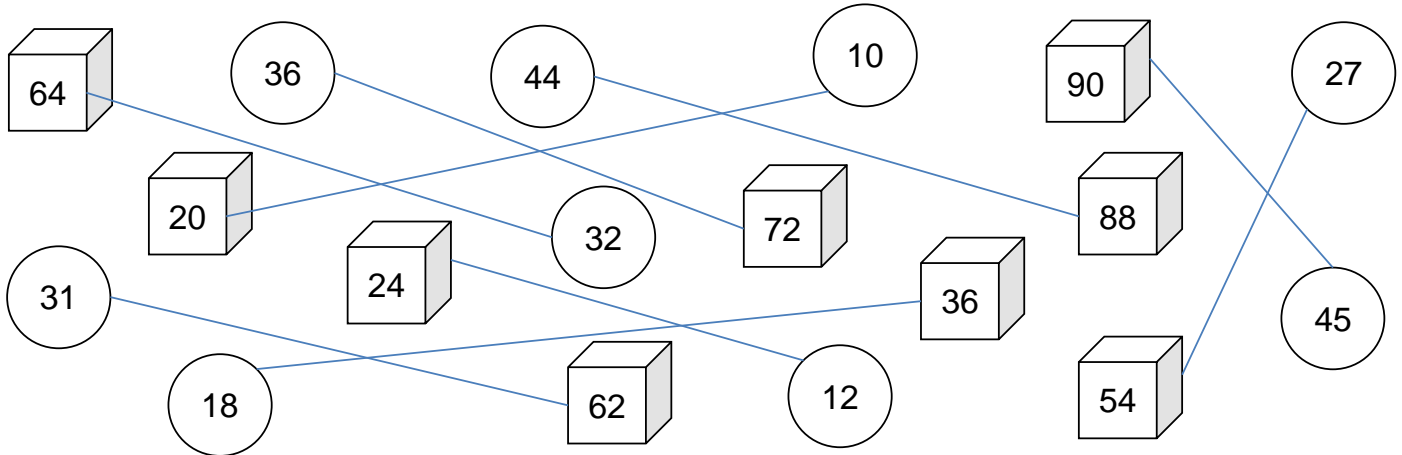


# DIVISION PRACTICE - MULTIPLES OF 2

# ANSWERS

Connect each number in a cube to a number half its size in a circle.



Mental math. Workout in your head one quarter of each amount.



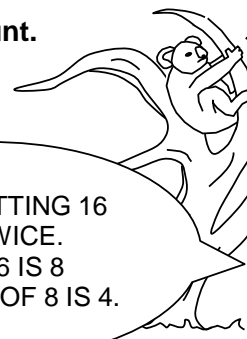
ONE QUARTER IS THE SAME AS DIVIDING BY 4, WHICH IS THE SAME AS DIVIDING BY TWO TWICE.

$$16 \div 4 = 4$$

OR

$$16 \div 2 = 8 \div 2 = 4$$

WE'RE CUTTING 16 IN HALF TWICE. HALF OF 16 IS 8 AND HALF OF 8 IS 4.



IF YOU KNOW HOW TO DIVIDE BY TWO YOU CAN DIVIDE BY 4.
